Let our stories serve as a beacon of hope to still suffering alcoholics who fear that AA does not have a place for them.



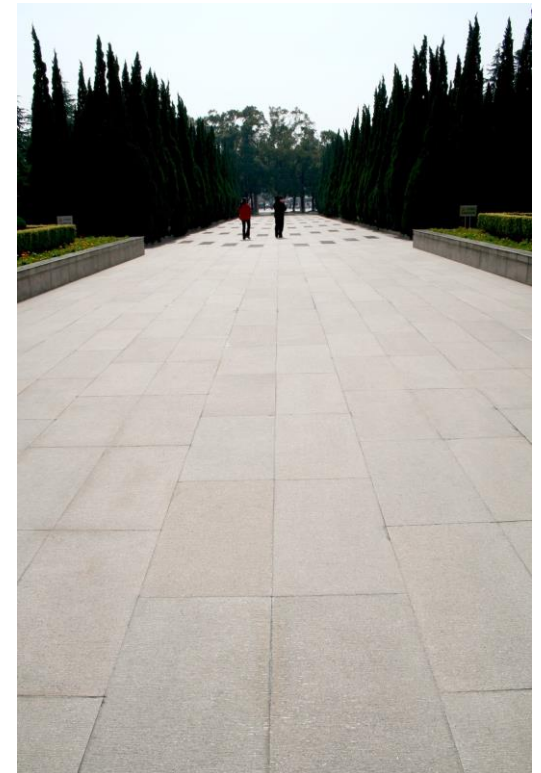

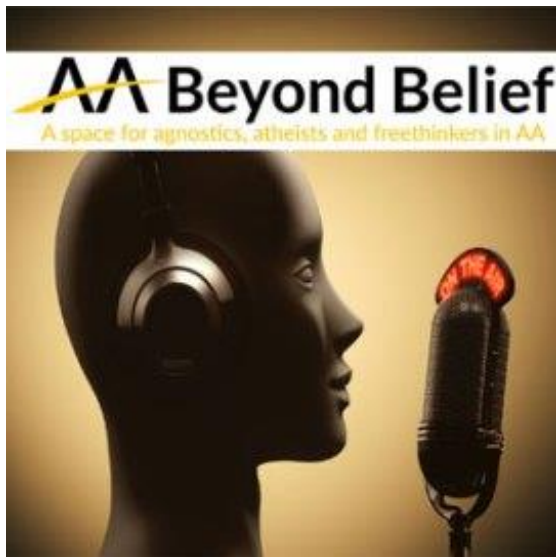
